What is INDEX?

- **INDEX** is a FREE information and referral service for people with disabilities.
- **INDEX** is a collection of the largest, the most complete and the most up-to-date databases of disability services in Massachusetts.
- **INDEX** is the coordinator of the Massachusetts Network of Information

Providers (**MNIP**), a collection of disability agencies that coordinate information and referral efforts.

Information Available

Resource Database

Includes programs and agencies that provide a wide range of services to individuals with disabilities.

Consultant Registry

Includes allied health professionals, educators, advocates and others. Also includes information on languages spoken. All have experience

working with individuals who have disabilities.

Physician Registry

Includes physicians who have experience with and interest in treating individuals with special health care needs.

Dental Registry

Lists dentists in Massachusetts who have experience serving people with disabilities.
